Criteria

Application: Applicants must complete and submit the attached application by **January 4, 2021**. (Please print neatly in black ink or type the necessary information.)

1. **Letters of Recommendation:** Each applicant must submit **one recent (within the last 6 months) letters of recommendation**, from someone familiar with the applicant's educational and career goals or from someone in the community (such as an employer, clergy, Boy or Girl Scout leader), but not a relative.
2. **Essay:** Each applicant must submit the **required essay** as shown on the following pages.

Final selection of the scholarship winners will be decided by a scholarship advisory committee (subject to the approval of the Board of Directors of ASHE). Recipients must provide evidence of enrollment. Note, past ASHE NY Metro Scholarship recipients are not eligible.

The American Society of Highway Engineers New York Metro Section shall notify the chosen scholarship recipients of its decision. Payment will be made at the Section's January Technical meeting. Selected student(s) will be notified in advance. Checks will be made payable to the recipient student(s).
